Phillips desired of establishing contact with Aguerro immediately because of his possible value to JMARC in the propaganda field.

Prior to meeting, Vidal checked Aguerro's branch file for derogatory reports () & summarized FBI # 05-86025 alleging Aguerro is not a bona-fide refugee but in fact a Castro agent. Additionally, William Pawley ~~had~~ had a memo of telephone conversation on 7 Apr. 1960 between William Pawley of Miami & L. O'Malley of A.R.A (sic) indicates Pawley feels Aguerro may be a counter spy for Castro
