In Cuba since July 1954 - continued outstanding performance - adept at recruiting agents. Has been a valuable deep cover agent handler.

18 April 1957 - Memo states Noemayr [redacted] ordered by Station to leave Cuba - an indigenous member of his agent not killed by Cuban authorities. Left Havana 18 Feb. 1957 - went to Costa Rica. To remain there with his family until about 6 May 1957 when he will be reassigned Cuba or another area.
