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Attachment dated 4 March 64, 7 pages
1. Rezzab on 26 Nov 63 in West Berlin
approached the Satellite Refugee Screening
Center saying he had info on Marina.
Rezzab then interviewed by CIA & US
military intelligence.
Rezzab born in Morocco on 3 Jan 38.
From 9/60 - 4/62 he studied at Maroc
Institut de Cinematographie. Rezzab
came to West Berlin as a student on 4/63.
Rezzab said he had info on Marina from

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show he saw in German newspaper on 25 Nov 63.
Said he knew her as Marina Nikolaeva.
She lived w/ her mother in Moscow. Father
is dead. Marina worked as punch card
operator of working class origin. Reggab
never knew her home address. He ~~was~~ esti-
mated she was 24.

Met her in Jan 61, at a dance sponsored
by Soviet student org for foreign students
at Patricia Lumumba C.

He saw her for 3-4 times a week until
5/61 when Reggab began to date the
friend of housewife Bourdakova.

He said after 2 weeks w/ her Marina
spoke openly of opposition to the Sov Regime
& said she wanted to marry a foreigner
so she could leave USSR.

Reggab didn't want to marry her. He had
a fiancee in Morocco, 6/61-9/61 - went back
to Morocco for vacation. On return Bourda-
kova told him that she hadn't seen
Marina for a month. He never heard of it.

He didn't think MO belonged to Komarmol.
He knew girls in Komarmol were supposed
to report on foreigners.

Reggab said he had a photo of Marina
w/ a letter from her dated 6/27/61 -
Casablanca. Reggab said he would need
official assistance to find the letter &
photo among his effects in Casablanca.

Reggab said MO was timid, romantic
& a sad face. He stated that she sub-
mitted to "his every wish".
His wife went to WH, State & FBI in 1/61.

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4 CIA Berlin station ordered to check out Reggab & his story. Station found that no more than Marina Oswald's first name & photo were available to press when Reggab approached the Satellite Refugee Screening Center. Data on MIO job & marriage only available after Reggab told his story. Station reported in Dec that Reggab was going to write his brother-in-law in Rabat to ask him to find the letter & photo.

5 By early Jan 64 MO denied ever knowing Reggab. CIA Rabat station was informed
6 Reggab case & were permitted to pay Reggab's airfare to Morocco to get the letter & photo but realized that Reggab might be Atlaty. CIA Berlin station was requested to ask Reggab to write another letter to his bro-in-law in Rabat. Any letter received in Berlin by Reggab would be subjected to careful technical exam by CIA.

Casablanca CIA sta found that Reggab while student in Moscow 1960-62 - had attended 3 meetings of Moroccan Communist Party Cell. Commun student through Reggab an informant from Moroccan Embassy because he was seen in conference w/ Moroccan Ambassador & had made several trips back to Morocco during school years, allegedly at his own expense.

By mid-Jan 64, no reply from Reggab bro-in-law. Since it was then known that MO never called on Moscow

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and married LHO in May 61, CIA Berlin
Estab suggested Reggab had fabricated the
stay for financial reasons. A polygraph
& further interrogation recommended.

6 2/1/61 - Reggab is polygraphed which
indicated Reggab had fabricated.
Also believed Reggab never wrote his
bro-in-law

Also polygraph shows Reggab had
very poor relations w/ his ~~bro~~^{father}-in-law
that couldn't go to house in Casablanca
to look for doc's.

CIA Berlin asked Reggab to write to
his brother-in-law again asking that
docs be sent to him. Reggab said
was returning to Morocco on 12 Feb
& would be in Berlin again on 1 March
He said he would send letter & photo
to a CIA Berlin address.

7 Reggab has left Berlin & no communi-
cation from him has been received.

On 21 Feb SS rep made contact w/
CIA Berlin. Stated he was instructed
to contact Reggab & get notarized
statements ^{from him} and to pick up a
letter & photo in Casablanca.

SS rep then briefed on CIA involvement
of which he was not aware. SS
rep decided to await instructions
from his HQ before further action.
Evidence available to CIA indicates
Reggab fabricated his stay.
