The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source & includes supplemental info from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports as primary checkers of the Agency.

1. Source id'd photo of Susa RODRIGUEZ Calderon and said that she had been connected w/ the PGI and the former secretary of the Young Communists in the Cuban Ministry of Exterior Commerce.
2. The Cuban government, according to source, thought that Rodriguez had been recruited by the United States Government while she was in Mexico and she was recalled to Cuba. Although source could not recall the details, he did recall something concerning her receiving a letter from an American. Source further recalled

something about an American student who visited Cuba and who was alleged to have made a recruitment pitch to Rodriguez (a was associated in some way) w/a pitch made to her.

### HA Comments

1. A report concerning Cuban diplomatic personnel in Mexico, dated 22 June 1963, gave the following biographic information on one Susa CAHILLON Carralero, possibly identical w/ Susa RODRIGUEZ Calderon. Calderon, secretary in the Commercial Office of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City, was born about 1940 in Cuba. She arrived in Mexico on 16 Jan 1963 and carried Cuban passport No. E/63/7. Calderon's mother, Benigna Carralero Carracedo, boarded on 16 Jan 63 & carried Cuban passport No. E/63/9. They reached at Aerodromo 28 Depto Mexico D.F. Mexico.

2 Two usually reliable sources w/ good connections in the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City, Mexico, gave a representative of this Agency the following information on Luisa Calderon possibly identical w/ Luisa Rodriguez Calderon

On 11 Dec 63, Luisa Calderon an employee of the Commercial Office of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City, made reservations to return to Cuba on Cubana Airline.

Calderon said that she would not be returning to Mexico. The report also notes that Calderon had arrived in Mexico on 16 Jan. 63.

1. On 9 Feb 65 AMMO 5/1 id'd a photo of Luisa Rodriguez Calderon who he stated had been connected w/ the DSI and Trofornia

Secretary of the Young Communists in  
the Cuban Ministry of Exterior Commerce.  
According to AMMUS/1, the Cuban  
Government thought Rodriguez had been  
recruited by the United States govern-  
ment while in Mexico so she was  
recalled to Cuba. Ammug/1 was  
not sure of the details but recalled  
something concerning her having  
received a letter from an American.  
Turkha, AMMUS/1 recalled something  
about an American student who  
was supposed to have made a  
recruitment pitch to Rodriguez  
or been associated in some manner  
w/ a pitch made to her. Ammug/1  
did not know the source of these  
alleged pitches.
