Files of this hq disclose fol: a. TURZEV resided at Frankfurt, Koenigswaerterstrasse 3 as sub-tenant of Olga PETROWSKY. PETROWSKY's daughter is Tatania KONDRASCHOW, born 13 Mar 20 in Sevastopol. Latter was married in 1952 to Grigorii KONDRASCHOW, born 8 May 24 in Rostov. She divorced him in Dec 55. A member of Labor Service, KONDRASCHOW redefected to USSR in Jun 56 under name of TELEGIN (rept as such in prev BFV list) and since that time he has been engaged in redefec- tion program geared to Labor Service pers. b. Tatania KONDRASCHOW was subj of visa screening inves- tigation during Jul 1956 and was interviewed a number of times concerning her husband's redefection and efforts to have her join him. time did she mention fact that she had been personally approached by ^{her} member Soviet Embassy or any other indiv to join her husband. She is curr in the US.

4. On the basis of the foregoing, believe you have valid excuse to [redacted] to prov you with aval info concerning approach to TURZEV particularly since [redacted] states first contact with PERMINOV took place in Jul 56 while PERMINOV was visiting female emigrant whose husband had been repatriated during same month to USSR.

5. Specific items of interest are fol:

a. Exactly what date and time did PERMINOV visit take place? How long did it last? Was PERMINOV alone or accompanied? ^{ACMP}

b. Was TURZEV present when discussion took place ^{btwn} between PERMINOV and Tatania KONDRASCHOW? Did he furnish details of the discussion? If not, did he hear about it later?

c. Was mother of Tatania (Olga PETROWSKY) present during the discussion? ^{btwn} [redacted]

d. In later meetings ^{btwn} between TURZEV and PERMINOV which [redacted] describes as discussion of repatriation problems, was case of Grigorii KONDRASCHOW ever discussed or did PERMINOV make any mention of Tatania? (In this regard it should be realized by [redacted] that all info known to Grigorii KONDRASCHOW about TURZEV must have been made known to PERMINOV.)

e. If answers to above queries are not aval in BFV files
