: CIA Contact Identification Credential

- 1. The Director of Security has authorized issuance of this Identification Credential to you because your official duties will require you to establish your identity as an employee of CIA.
- 2. Use of the credential will be governed by the following provisions:
 - (a) The credential will be carried only when necessary to conduct official Agency business. At all other times, if feasible, the credential will be secured in a CIA facility.
 - (b) The credential will not be utilized for personal identification purposes.
 - (c) The credential may be withdrawn, without notice, upon indication of misuse.
 - (d) Should the credential be lost, immediate notice will be forwarded to the Director of Central Intelligence, Attention: Director of Security, by the most expeditious means available; a thorough investigation will be initiated to determine the circumstances surrounding the loss and reported to the Director of Security.
 - (e) Penalties for loss of credentials will be drastic and may include dismissal from the Agency.
 - (f) Credentials are considered as Registered Documents and are subjected to periodic accountability audits.
 - (g) Credentials will be returned to the Director of Security when no longer required by the individual to whom issuea.
- 3. Deviation from the preceding provisions will result in severe punitive measures.
