

If he wishes to make copies available to a Latin American diplomat for passage to his own country, Headquarters clearance should be obtained before copies are furnished. This is because Headquarters is endravoring to make appropriate arrangements for passage of the paper through other channels. It is believed, therefore, that the most appropriate use of the material would be as background for discussion with individual representatives of latin American countries. However, there is no objection to its being used as a basis for their comments or reports to their own governments.
