For the information of the WFO, by letter dated 4/8/63, NY file 134-35, a request by JACQUES HERVE on 4/3/63, asked information about the ALDERSONS of 5803 Burlinghan, Houston, Texas. His Paris Office had advised that a Captain SOUETRE, a fugitive of the OAS, had received a letter from the ALDERSONS wishing him well. This letter signed LARREY was received in December, 1962. (Algerian Secret Police)

By letter dated 5/3/63, Houston forwarded background information concerning this family. By letter dated 5/21/63, the Bureau advised what information from the Houston letter could be furnished to HERVE. This information was given to HERVE on 5/28/63.
